The first 5 winners, including the first prize, will be exhibited at Maison Blanche from October 17 to November 24, 2024.

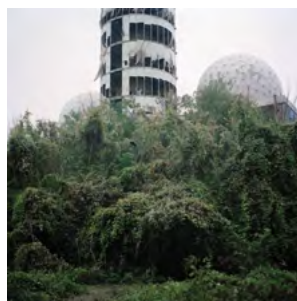

APPLICATIONS

All photographers-authors, regardless of nationality or age, may apply for the PRIX MAISON BLANCHE 2024. The jury will choose the files that present a personal work, in the form of a series. The main criterion for selection remains the expression of an author's vision.

JURY

A jury composed of photography professionals will select the winners. For information, the 2023 jury was composed of : Emmanuelle Hascoët from the Bibliothèque nationale de France, Fabienne Pavia from Le Bec en l'air editions, Nicolas Misery, Director of the Museums of Marseille, Oriane Ciantar Olive, photographer, winner of the PMB2023, and Christophe Asso, director, Photo Marseille festival.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Participation in the PRIX MAISON BLANCHE 2024 implies acceptance of the rules and regulations (available on request by email). The winner being rewarded by the publication of a book, the candidates guarantee that the series they submit to the examination of the jury is free of any publishing commitment and accept the publication of their work in the form of a book in the Prix Maison Blanche collection.

COMPOSITION OF THE FILE

The participation file for the PRIX MAISON BLANCHE 2024 must be made up of the following elements:

- **A document in PDF format, including a CV and a text explaining the approach and the series presented.**
- **A series of 20 to 50 photographs (JPEG / RGB / File Size : 1 Mo maximum).**
